A self-governing organisation of German universities:



- so that higher education institutions may contribute to development and build bridges to surmount conflicts.





Ph.D. short- and long-term research fellowships



- Open to all disciplines:
- Studies in libraries/archives
- Experiments
- Field work
- Duration:
- 1-6 months (short-term), no extension

"Darüber hinaus können sich auch nichtdeutsche Studierende und Hochschulabsolventen bewerben, wenn sie in einem Studiengang an einer deutschen Hochschule eingeschrieben sind mit dem Ziel, den Abschluss an der deutschen Hochschule zu erreichen, Oder wenn sie an einer deutschen Hochschule promovieren."

- > 7 months 1 year (long-term), extension possible
- **Host:** university, non-university research institution, industry laboratory
- Destinations: open to all countries, research stays in several countries may be combined in one application


Postdoc Research Fellowships



Goal: further academic qualification

- Open to all disciplines
- Open to all destinations
- Research stays in several countries may be combined within one application
- short- and long-term fellowships for German early-career scientists holding a Ph.D.
- pursuit of independent research project at a research institution of your choice









Postdoc Research Fellowships – DAAD support



Financial support

- basic scholarship rate: € 1,365 (<=30 years), € 1,416 (>30 years)
- Expatriate allowance, buying rate differential
- Allowance for partner + children/childcare
- Travel allowance
- Research allowance
- Support for re-integration after research stay abroad

USA



Japan

> 30 years, one child basic rate expatriate allowance child support buying rate diff. total:



€ 1,927€ 400€ 536€ 4,340

Rates are adjusted regularly



Postdoc Research Fellowships – Family Allowances



Child allowance for kids under 12 (400 Euro per month for the first child and 100 Euro per month for any additional child).

If the scholar is accompanied by his/her child:

Extension of the funding period for up to 100 % (maximum extension 12 months)

or:

Coverage of the monthly costs for child care up to the basic scholarship rate.
Combinations are possible!

Relocation allowance for the return to Germany at the end of the scholarship.

Selection Criteria P.R.I.M.E.

1. Achievements to date:

- academic performance, grades, study duration, number and quality of publications;
- other achievements; overall impression of the applicant in consideration; transnational mobility; intersectoral mobility; social commitment; unavoidable delays in academic development.
- 2. Project quality and long-term career perspectives:
- research project;
- planned implementation(time and work schedule); suitability of the German/foreign host institution and the support provided there; suitability of the foreign host institution and the support provided there.

Postdoc Research Funding – Application deadlines

- Application for short-term fellowships (3 to 6 months):
 Anytime (expect at least three months for the selection process)
- Application for long-term fellowships (7 to 24 months):

<u>Deadline</u>	Selection	Starting date
15 November	February	April
15 June	October	December

Application for P.R.I.M.E. Scholarships (may be different next year)

<u>Deadline</u>	Selection	Starting date
01 February	June	September

Who?

> The program is open to Ph.D. students, postdocs, faculty/senior scientists, emeriti

Where?

Travel abroad to international conferences or lectures upon invitation

What?

- > Travel allowances, depending on country
- daily allowance for board and accomodation
- conference fees (earlybird-rate)

Preconditions?

- active participation
- lecture or poster-session

Application?

- No later than 4 months before conference starts
- No later than 1 month prior to departure for lectures upon invitation



Funding of Congress Participation and Scientific Talks Abroad



Duration: > maximum of eight conference days

> maximum of ten days in case of invited lecturers

Eligibility: > junior researchers: every 12 months

> senior researchers: every 24 months

Numbers: > applications: ~ 5,000 per year

➤ approved: ~ 2,500

> ratio: 1:2

FITweltweit – Scholarships for Computer Scientists



Goal: increase interest among computer scientists in a scientific career and international collaboration

Programme supports research stays abroad:

- Master/Ph.D. students
- short-term scholarships, 1-6 months
- worldwide: universities, non-university research institutions, industry laboratories

German Academic Exchange Service

no tuition fees covered

- **Postdocs**
- short- and long-term scholarships, 3-24 months
- Berkeley (ICSI) or Tokyo (NII)





special support for re-integration



RISE – Research Internships in Science and Engineering













Goal: Promote the exchange of students from North America and Great Britain to Germany in the fields of natural science, engineering and life sciences

- Application: Ph.D. candidates can apply for funds for a foreign research assistant (undergrad. student)
- database open until Nov. 30
- Universität Frankfurt, 01.06.2015 WW. daad.de/rise
 Dr. Christian Schäfer, DAAD S18 **Duration:** short-term research stays (2-3 months)



Exchange Involving Projects - PPP (Programm zum Projektbezogenen Personenaustausch)

Goal: Intensify cooperation between international and German research groups

- **Programme:**
- for universities and non-university research institutions
- bilateral programme with 29 partner countries
- **Disciplines:**
- varies, depending on specific programm agreement
- **Eligibility:**
- Research groups: postdocs, senior scientists, professors apply for their institution



Exchange Involving Projects - PPP (Programm zum Projektbezogenen Personenaustausch)

Funding:

- M.A./Ph.D. students, Postdocs, Senior Scientists
- Special emphasis lies on the support of young scholars, i.e. graduate students working on their thesis, Ph.D. students and postdocs

Duration:

- total: usually up to 2 years with possible extension for a third year (depending on the country)
- per stay: usually 1 month, with some exceptions

Remark:

funding for project itself must be guaranteed by other www.daad.de/ppp sources

Re-integration of German Scientists from Abroad



Goal: Help German academics abroad return to a professional career in Germany

- Target group
- Ph.D. students, postdocs, senior scientists
- Two types of funding
- Travel grants for job interviews and lectures
- return scholarships (up to 6 months) to re-enter the German research landscape

Research Fellowships – Selection Criteria



- Academic qualification
- Publications
- Project (scientific quality, realistic planning, feasibility)
- The "Fit" (project, institution, career plans)
- personality, extra-curricular activities



Frequent criticisms from reviewers in the P.R.I.M.E. (www.daad.de/prime) program

- There is a whole suite of literature the candidate has ignored.
- The timescale for the project strikes me as unrealistic.
- Candidate's previous publications not very visible.
- Clearer description and justification of the methodological procedure and research design.
- Time planning close to impossible.

German Academic Exchange Service

- Very unclear design of the experiments.
- Very descriptive project that is not hypothesis driven.



Frequent criticisms from reviewers in the P.R.I.M.E. (www.daad.de/prime) program

- Project is a continuation of the PhD thesis, i.e. a broadening of the field is missing.
- The candidate should have made an attempt to explain better how his previous experience equips him for this project ...
- Contingency plan. There isn't one. What happens if things don't go as expected?
- Training opportunities. It is not explicitly stated what new knowledge and experience the candidate will obtain.
- Timeline for ethics approval is not included.


