Why is it important for the scientific community to be more representative of the population at large? How can diversity be increased? In this talk, I will discuss modern understandings of challenges to diversity, like stereotype threat and unconscious bias. I will also present findings on the status of women and minorities specific to the nuclear physics community.
